“ I am heartbroken to tell you that my beloved sister Krysia died on Monday, Dec. 3 2018.

In October 2015, she was diagnosed with advanced ovarian cancer. Krysia spent the next three years of her life valiantly fighting the disease. She underwent surgery, followed by multiple rounds of chemotherapy. During that time, although she was often physically compromised, she continued to live life according to her e-mail byline : "Life is NOT a dress rehearsal. Live it!" She and I shared many adventures during those three years. Together, we spent a week camping and hiking in the Mogollon Rim area in Arizona. We also played like little kids at the GoApe zipline area in Kansas City, visited Carlsbad Caverns (yes, we saw the millions of bats flying out - it was TOTALLY awesome!!), and giggled our way through the Meow Wolf house in Santa Fe. Not to mention trips to the Great Sand Dunes in Colorado, Seven Falls, hiking in Colorado, and ... well, you get the idea.

She was my playmate, and I will miss her terribly.
