Born July 21, 1935 in Conway, Arkansas to Farley and Curtis Helen Stevenson, Allen was blessed with intelligence and athletic abilities that would serve him throughout his life. He was a Golden Glove Lightweight, Middleweight, and Heavyweight boxer, as well as, a gifted football, baseball, and basketball player. While playing basketball for Boston University, he became the first black captain of varsity basketball in the team's history. This led to a semi-pro career in basketball. His educational achievements from Boston University and Donnelly College served him well throughout his employ at GM Leeds Plant and as the Director of Social Services at the Juvenile Detention Center of Kansas City, MO. His loving wife, Janet survives of the home along with children; Andrew Thomas of Pleasant Hill, IA, Tina Thomas of Pearland, TX, Rhonda (Marvin) Watson of Chattanooga, TN, and Curtis (Julie) Stevenson of Lee's Summit, MO.
