Ann went to be with her Lord February 17, 2015 at the age of 93. Annie Louise Brown was born in Troutman, North Carolina on December 22, 1921 to parents Mason Edgar Brown and Annie Charles Waugh Brown. Ann had two brother, Charles and Mason and two sisters Catherine and Mildred.

Ann graduated high school in High Point, NC. She furthered her studies at the university of South Carolina School of Nursing. She was the floor Nurse at High Point City Hospital before marrying William Walker Jr. on November 29, 1942 in Charleston, S. Carolina.
