Arthur Lee Holman, 82 formerly of Excelsior Springs, Missouri passed away at his home in Helotes Texas, at 9:33am on Sunday, November 29, 2015. The cause was complications associated with congestive heart failure. Born December 15, 1932, in Lexington, Missouri, Arthur lived in Kansas City, Missouri and San Antonio, Texas, before settling in Helotes. Art was a member of the Primitive Baptist church from 1956 until the time of his death still serving as a Deacon in Bethany Primitive Baptist church in San Antonio, Texas.
