



Eunice L. Morgan

August 26, 1926 - September 2, 2016

Eunice Seiter Morgan, 90, passed away peacefully on September 2, 2016 at North Kansas City Hospital. She was born on August 26th, 1926 to August and Frances Seiter in Troy, Kansas. She was the 11th of 12 children born to the couple. Eunice graduated from Troy High School in 1944. She was employed by the Army Effects Bureau of the Department of the Army where she wrote letters of regret to families of soldiers killed in action and examined their personal effects prior to them being sent to their families. During World War II, Mrs. Morgan began corresponding with John F. Morgan, a friend of her brother serving with the U.S. Army on the Aleutian Islands. The couple married on March 15th, 1946 and lived for a time in converted United States Air Force barracks at Rosecrans Field, KS. They subsequently lived in the St. Joseph, MO area until their move to Kansas City in 1947. Their son Dennis was born in 1947, followed by John in 1948 and Tom in 1952.

Mrs. Morgan was employed by Panhandle Eastern Pipeline Company, rising from payroll clerk to contract manager. After her retirement, Mrs. Morgan worked with the Clay County Election Board and volunteered at the Nearly New charity store. She was an active member of the Fairview Christian Church and participated in the many functions of the church. Mrs. Morgan enjoyed travel, casinos, the Kansas City Royals and the Kansas City Chiefs. She was admired for her quilting and needlework skills.

She is preceded in death by her beloved husband of fifty-five years, John F. Morgan and her granddaughter Angela Morgan Bauman. Survivors include her sons Dennis A. Morgan and his wife Denice, John F. Morgan, Jr. and Thomas L. Morgan; her grand-daughters Terri Morgan Rezen and her husband Jeremy, Katie Morgan, Bailey Morgan and Tracey Morgan; and her great-grandchildren Jack Morgan, Luke Bauman, Josh Bauman, and Abbie Bauman and their father Forrest.

Visitation will be held on September 7 from 9:00 – 11:00 AM at Fairview Christian Church, 1800 NE 65th Street, Gladstone, MO with service to follow. Interment will be at Mt Olive Cemetery, Troy KS.
