



Hideko M. Hensley

March 23, 1931 - July 16, 2014

Hideko (Mukoyama) Hensley, age 83, passed away July 16, 2014 at St Luke's Hospital in Kansas City, Missouri. Family will receive friends from 2 to 4 pm on Monday, July 21, 2014 at Kearney First Baptist Church, 303 S. Grove, Kearney, Missouri. Funeral services will be held following visitation, at 4 pm, also at Kearney First Baptist Church. Burial will follow in the Fairview Cemetery, Kearney, Missouri.

Hideko was born in Odawara, Hiakawa Province, Japan on March 23, 1931 to Inokichi and Koshigu (Aoki) Mukoyama. Hideko was preceded in death by her husband of 37 years, Robert J. Hensley, 2 sisters, Yukiko Fujita and Kimie Jinno, and her brother, Taichi Ishida. Survivors include her 3 children: Toney Hensley (wife Kim) of Lee's Summit, Missouri; Tom Hensley (wife Donna) of Lee's Summit, Missouri; and Tammy Smith (husband Stefan) of Kearney, Missouri; 7 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

Hideko married Robert (Bob) Hensley on January 20, 1954, and emigrated from Japan on June 7, 1954, leaving from Yokohama, Japan, and arriving in San Francisco, California by boat. Hideko and Bob initially settled in North Kansas City, Missouri, and later moved to Kearney, Missouri. Hideko worked as a seamstress in Kansas City, Missouri before retiring to raise her children. She enjoyed gardening, her grandchildren and Kansas City Chiefs football.
