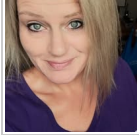

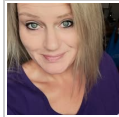

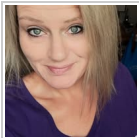

I wish this picture wasnt so dark. This is probably the last picture i took of him. This was taken Nov 4th, on his 50th birthday.

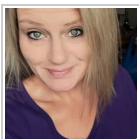
