She loved her work and was saddened that her health could not allow her to continue. She worked as a Senior Manager II with the Solvency Regulation Department of NAIC up until January 2019. She was proud to have traveled to all 50 states, the US Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico. She loved vacationing in Hawaii, California, Florida, and the Caribbean to name a few top destinations. Julie enjoyed creating or experiencing extraordinary moments in the middle of an ordinary day and having family and friends experience them with her. One of those is the love story between she and her

beloved husband, Keith. 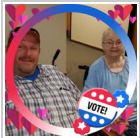
