lived in O'Fallon, Missouri which brought a visit from the Feds in search of what might be interfering with Federal Communications. He was 13 years old and did not realize he had caused trouble. He took it apart and apologized. He built things to fly around our heads that made us duck!

Mike was a wrestler, football player, a musician, playing the trumpet and a happy soul who did as Jesus into his heart as a teen.
