Norma Parrott died Wednesday, 2/26/14 after a brief illness and was surrounded by family at the time of her death. She was born August 30, 1931 to Ray and Dorothy (Whittaker) Osborne. She grew up in the St. Joseph, Missouri area and attended nursing school St. Joseph and graduated in 1952. After several years as a private duty nurse, she moved to Detroit for nurse anesthetist training. After returning to the Kansas City area, she worked for Dr. Safferstein and they provided anesthesia care in many hospitals in the area, including those that served the African-American community. While in Kansas City, she met Robert W. Parrott. They married in January, 1958 and moved back to St. Joseph, Missouri. He died in 1986. Following his death, she moved back to the Kansas City area. During her career as a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist, she practiced anesthesia as the field evolved from ether to the modern surgical suite. She retired in 1999 from Westport Anesthesia after 50 years of nursing. While working, she was active in Girl Scouts, campaigned for development of services for learning disabled youth in public schools and helped with various church activities. Following retirement, she kept busy with genealogy, Daughters of the American Revolution and several antique clubs. She loved to travel and doted on her five grandchildren. She proudly served on the Riverside Park Board. Survivors include her son, William S. Parrott

(Sarah) of Roeland Park, Kansas, her daughters Nancy A. Parrott of Riverside, Missouri and Amy L. Brown (Dave) of Overland Park, Kansas. Grandchildren who survive include Sara Brown, Grace Parrott, Megan Parrott, Robert Parrott and Marian Parrott. The family plans a private interment. A service for the witness of the resurrection will be held Sunday, March 9, 2014 at 3:00 p.m. at Pine Ridge Presbyterian Church in Kansas City, Missouri. The family will receive friends at the church at 2:00 p.m. Memorial contributions may be directed in her memory to the White Alloe Chapter of the DAR or Pine Ridge Presbyterian Church.
