Robert Lee Beagley, 60 of Kansas City passed away June 11, 2014 at North Kansas City Hospital. Robert was born August 28, 1953 to Marvin Lee and Thelma Lea (Foster) Beagley in Hoxie, Kansas. Robert was a graduate of Oak Park High School, Class of 1972. After High School, Robert worked many years in the steel industry prior to having a major heart attack when he was 36. Robert will be remembered fondly for getting kids involved in sports. He himself was a KC Royals, Chiefs, Nascar and Jawhawks fan, but his passion for youth sports topped the list. He was a Coach for North Kids Cobras Wrestling, several Baseball Leagues and started Girls Softball in North Kansas City. He had a passion for car racing and was a reporter for the Sun News, following drivers at Lakeside Speedway and I-70 Speedway. Robert volunteered at many events; he received "Volunteer of the Year" Award from the American Royal for one of his many years of service and he was also proud to be a volunteer for Heart of America Stand Down for Homeless Vets. Robert is preceded in death by his father.
