Sean Patrick Morelli, 44, of Liberty, Missouri, passed peacefully in his home on May 16, 2017 surrounded by family after fighting a two year battle with brain cancer.

Sean was born in Ellsworth, Maine on April 7, 1973, the son of Gary Son and Enza (Papalia) Turner. He grew up helping his father with gardening and many outdoor endeavors and adventures. He spent much time in the country with his grandparents, helping in many ways. He and his mother and family also spent some time living in Italy with his Italian born grandmother. He was a "farmer" at heart who always tried to keep a garden going and dreamed of a house in the country with lots of land. He owned chickens and was their caretaker mostly, but his family all enjoyed fresh eggs. He was a member of the Missouri Militia 1st and 3rd and loved the camaraderie and friendships he developed with those men. He was always thinking about survival preparations, with a strong desire to provide for and protect his family. Sean was an entrepreneur at heart. From as early as his teenage years, he pursued and dreamed about working full-time for himself and being his own boss. He created a survival prep store website and also ran a physical store with the same name for a while in Parkville. He was a self-taught programmer and website developer. He pursued a degree in IT and was able to complete his associate degree online so he could continue learning in this area. He could do just about anything with computers, a skill which others appreciated

greatly! Sean was a talented artist and a great story teller. He loved to laugh and make others laugh. He enjoyed a good joke, especially inside jokes with his friends and family. He was a dreamer and loved to say often "Picture this. . ." He loved all kinds of food, but especially his mother's Italian cooking, cheesecake, cream puffs, coffee.

Sean leaves behind his wife Missy (Calandrino) Morelli, his son, Jacob (17), and his daughters, Victoria (15), Lianna (12) and Sophia (6). He is also survived by his parents, Gary Son and his wife Eva and Enza Turner and her husband Jim, his siblings, Hillary Dary, Vanessa Turner, Michael Son and Amanda Son.
