She became "Momma Short" & "Grandma" to many other kids, including some of her bus riders over the last 22 years.

Valree was born in Melbourne Arkansas, but moved to Independence as a young girl and has brought much of that "country flavor" into our city lives over the years. When the Funeral director asked what her favorite color was, someone hollered out "food"!

Food & Children were her passion, so her family has decided to have food barrels available at the Church for non-perishable food items which will be delivered to help families in need and envelopes for monetary donations that will be donated to the local Ronald McDonald House.
