“ *My condolences to your family. I know Vivian will be missed. I met Ms. Bozarth during a visit to Brown County, Indiana, with my father, Ed Livingston. My name is Leslie Livingston. I really hope I have reached the family of Vivian, the artist. I have a stunning still life she painted. She made a deal with my dad. \$25 a month until paid off, and we drove off with it. She trusted dad, and sure enough, he paid every month, until he had paid her in full. I was very young, but I remember everything that happened. It must have been sometime in the mid 1960s. Her still life is a vase with a pink and green flower, napkin, cut loaf of bread. and a white bowl with blue decoration, filled with eggs. This wonderful piece of art adorned our kitchen wall. Dad took it with him when he left the house. Now I have bought my childhood home, and I placed Vivian's still life on the wall, back where it belongs. I have looked online for Vivian Bozarth since I have had a computer. I was ill a few years, and here I type in her name and find out she had passed. I so wanted to talk to her, to see if she remembered my dad and me. If I have reached the wrong family, I am very sorry, But, I do not think there are many women artists by the same name.
